## WHAT'S ON AND WHAT'S NOT IN 2016

With respect to on ground and behaviour expectations the WGJFC position and in most of the following cases is the Competition position:

## WHAT'S ON AND WHAT'S NOT IN 2016 (CONT)

**Mouth guards are compulsory** for training and game day i.e. a no mouthguard no play policy is in operation.

As the clubs insurance only covers 70% of dental costs, if a player loses teeth parents and carers will be out of pocket a lot.

It does happen...



**E-points** –Teams gets a premiership point at the beginning of each game for good behaviour i.e. each game is worth 5 premiership points.

The team loses this e-point regardless of whether we win or lose if the team gets a red or yellow card.

This is 15 premiership points over a season which is a significant factor in where a team finishes on the ladder.

Every e-point matters when you consider that WGJFC Yr 8 team missed out on playing finals last year by only .03%!

## WHAT'S ON AND WHAT'S NOT IN 2016 – ZERO TOLERANCE

There are several situations which the competition and club has a **zero tolerance** for.

The committee, coaching and management groups of all teams fully support it and the players are aware of this.

**No swearing** – Zero tolerance. The umpires will pay an automatic free kick for players swearing.

For those that don't know them the Laws of the Game (15.10 10 (d)) provide for a free kick against a team when:

*...the field Umpire is of the opinion that a Player has used abusive, insulting, threatening or obscene language and/or gesture.*

This makes it pretty simple, if the player swears or makes an obscene gesture they will give away a free kick and will have to wear the consequences from their Coach and teammates.

The competition message is simple, **be civil to each other and let your football do the talking!!!**

Players will need to find new or different word for expressing their displeasure with something.

**Umpire abuse** – Zero tolerance for players, officials **or supporters**. We have never seen a free kick decision reversed because somebody didn't like it and never will.

The Umpires decision is the decision, we cop it, we learn from it and we move on.

The Umpires get most decisions right, let's be thankful for that.

## WHAT'S ON AND WHAT'S NOT IN 2016 – ZERO TOLERANCE

**Vilification (of any kind)** - Zero tolerance. It has no place in society and particularly so at a junior sporting activity.

The WGJFC will never tolerate vilification of its own or other players for any or no reason.

## CONCUSSION

The WGJFC policy on concussion in 2016 is the same as it was in 2015...without exception.

If a player is concussed they will sit out the next week's training and game and require a Doctors medical certificate to restart training/playing.

If they incur a second concussion they will miss a further 3 weeks (and a Doctors certificate).

A third concussion will result in the player sitting out for the rest of the season.
