2015 FUNDRAISER... CLEAN OUT THOSE WARDROBES AND CUPBOARDS



One of the final WGJFC fundraising initiatives of the year will be run in August and it won't cost you a cent. It will even give you the chance to get ahead of your spring cleaning and an excuse to spend those hard earned \$\$\$ on some new gear. The WGJFC club rooms will be a Cash4Clothing Depot for the last 4 weekends of football (Saturday and Sunday).

How It Works: The program has been developed to enable participating groups the option of holding regular clothing collections with the recycling of unwanted clothing items exchanged for cash. Once collected all of the bags of clothing will be weighed and the club will receive payment passed on the weight of the total amount collected.

Items that are accepted: Men's, ladies and children's clothes. Paired shoes tied together. Handbags, ties, belts, jumpers and bed linen. Items should be suitable to be worn.

Items Not Accepted: Duvets or pillows (synthetic or feather), blankets, cushions, offcuts, towels, carpets, rugs, curtains, dirty or wet clothing. Items not fit for reuse.

If you could bring your items to the clubrooms on game day in a garbage bag or similar and deposit them in the marked area of the Ellersdale clubrooms that would be greatly appreciated as all money raised will go to the WGJFC.
