PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

The objective of the Subiaco District is to provide an opportunity for children of all ages and abilities to play football in a fun and safe environment. All players, parents, coaches, officials and spectators are expected to adhere to this Code of Conduct.

1. Understand and follow *By-Law 1 – The Spirit of Junior Football in WA* at all times. This by-law states that it is incumbent on every participant in the game to ensure they will:
2. Positive and sportsmanlike behaviour should be exhibited by extending standard courtesies to the opposing team i.e. pre-match courtesies, thanking umpires/referees and opposing team after the match.
3. Deliberate violence in any sport is unacceptable and physical contact will be restricted to that allowed within the rules of the game.
4. Verbal provocation and response to provocation is unacceptable.
5. Never use foul or derogatory language towards umpires, players, opponents, officials or spectators.
6. Never argue with, abuse, threaten or intimidate an umpire or official, irrespective of whether you disagree with a decision. The umpire/referee's decision is always final and is not to be contested.
7. Immodest behaviour in victory or success, and manifestation of self disgust at an error or failure, are acts of poor sportsmanship and are unacceptable.
8. Unfair or illegal tactics to gain advantage are unacceptable and should never be used.
9. Display respect to team-mates, coaches and team officials. Bullying will not be tolerated.
10. If you disagree with an official's decision raise the issue through the appropriate channels (your Team Manager initially) rather than questioning or abusing the official in public.
11. Encourage all players to follow the rules and respect any officials decisions.

By signing this Code of Conduct you understand your role in providing a positive game environment for all and acknowledge that any breaches will result in penalties being imposed by your junior club and/or the WAFC.
