No "win at all costs" mentality that leads to players missing out, not having even game time or not developing whole ground ability

Not sharing player performance recognition

# 2024 COMPETITIONS UPDATE

## **VESTS**

Interchange Steward – this is a new vest (purple) but will be rolled in over the next 2 seasons (required by 2026). Not mandatory for season 2024 and 2025.

Parent Umpire vests are now required to be the Orange vest (blue vests have been replaced with orange). Runners Vests – all are now required to be pink (fluro yellow vests have now been replaced with pink).

### **GAME DAY**

Modifieds — Only x 4 allowed in coaches box. Coach, Runner, Manager, First Aid Opens — 5 allowed in coaches box. Coach, Assistant Coach, Runner, Manager, First Aid Interchange steward to either sit to the side of coaches box or in the middle of the two coaches box.

## **FIXTURING**

- The first 5 rounds will be floating fixtures with all teams placed within the one age group competition to allow for match ups to determine the competitions make up after round 5.
- The WAFC reserves the right to grade and regrade throughout the season to provide players with competitive matches.
- Any re-fixturing that occurs after the commencement of the season will be at the discretion of the WAFC. Changes will be made with fairness and transparency in mind, aiming to minimise disruptions to the overall competition.

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- The Even up rule will be in place only for Year 3 9 mixed competitions
- Year 9/10 Female, Year 10 Male, Year 11/12 Male and Female will use the even down rule.
- 5 Players maximum on the bench Youth only. Modified unlimited.


